Information about the use of cookies

What is a cookie?

The Data Controller uses so-called cookies when visiting the website. A cookie is a package of information consisting of letters and numbers that our website sends to your browser in order to save certain settings, facilitate the use of our website and help us collect some relevant, statistical information about our visitors. Cookies do not contain personal information and are not suitable for identifying an individual user. Cookies often contain a unique identifier - a secret, randomly generated string of numbers - that is stored by your device. Some cookies expire after you close the website, while some are stored on your computer for a longer period of time.

Legal background and legal basis for cookies:

The background to data processing is provided by Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information. Act (Infotv.) and the provisions of Act CVIII of 2001 on certain issues of electronic commerce services and services related to the information society. The legal basis for data processing is your consent in accordance with Section 5 (1) a) of the Infotv.

Main characteristics of the cookies used by the website:

RTB personalized retargeting cookies: They may appear to previous visitors or users when browsing other websites on the Google Display Network or when searching for terms related to its products or services

Strictly necessary cookies for operation: These cookies are essential for the use of the website and enable the use of basic functions of the website. Without them, many functions of the website will not be available to you. The lifespan of this type of cookie is limited solely to the duration of the session.

Cookies to improve user experience: These cookies collect information about the user's use of the website, for example, which pages are visited most often or what error messages they receive from the website. These cookies do not collect information that identifies the visitor, i.e. they work with completely general, anonymous information. We use the data obtained from them to improve the performance of the website. The lifespan of this type of cookie is limited only to the duration of the session. If you do not accept the use of cookies, certain functions will not be available to you.

Data management related to ordering and invoicing

Legal background and legal basis of data processing:

The background of data processing is the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on the right to information self-determination and freedom of information (Infotv.) and Act C of 2000 on accounting (Sztv.). The legal basis for data processing is your consent in accordance with Section 5 (1) a) of the Infotv. and - in the event of withdrawal of your consent - the fulfillment of the legal obligation imposed on the Data Controller under the Sztv.

Purpose of data processing: Issuing invoices in accordance with the law and fulfilling the obligation to retain accounting documents. Pursuant to Section 169 (1)-(2) of the Sztv., business entities must retain accounting documents that directly and indirectly support accounting settlements.

The scope of the data processed: Name, address, e-mail address, telephone number.

Duration of data processing: The invoices issued must be kept for 8 years from the date of issue of the invoice pursuant to Section 169 (2) of the Hungarian Information Act. We would like to inform you that if you withdraw your consent to the issue of the invoice, the Data Controller is entitled to keep your personal data obtained during the issue of the invoice for 8 years pursuant to Section 6 (5) a) of the Hungarian Information Act.
